

## Explore Mont-Sainte-Anne with its new alpine touring network!



Beaupré, January 13, 2016 - Mont-Sainte-Anne launched a new activity last Saturday with two exclusive ascent paths for alpine skiers. Alpine touring appeared over the past few years and is becoming really popular in the area. You can now climb Mont-Sainte-Anne's summit with your skins or your split board and then enjoy your favorite slope among the 71 available.

### WHAT SETS MONT-SAINTE-ANNE APART

These new paths are located one on the South Side of the mountain and the other on North Side. This allows the alpine skiers to ski both faces of the mountain, covering a variety of terrain. Another plus for Mont-Sainte-Anne's trails is that they are located deep in the forest. While alpine touring in ski resorts is most of the time offered along the existing downhill slopes, these trails take hikers through picturesque scenery of the mountain forests.

### THE DETAILS

- Schedule: 8:30 to 2:30 p.m. [last climb]
- Rates: \$ 7.99 \* only for daily ticket and \$ 29.99 \* for season pass [\* taxes]
- Length of trails: South cling 5,3km / North climb 3,1km. **Please take note that you have to climb South to get to North Side slopes and trail.**
