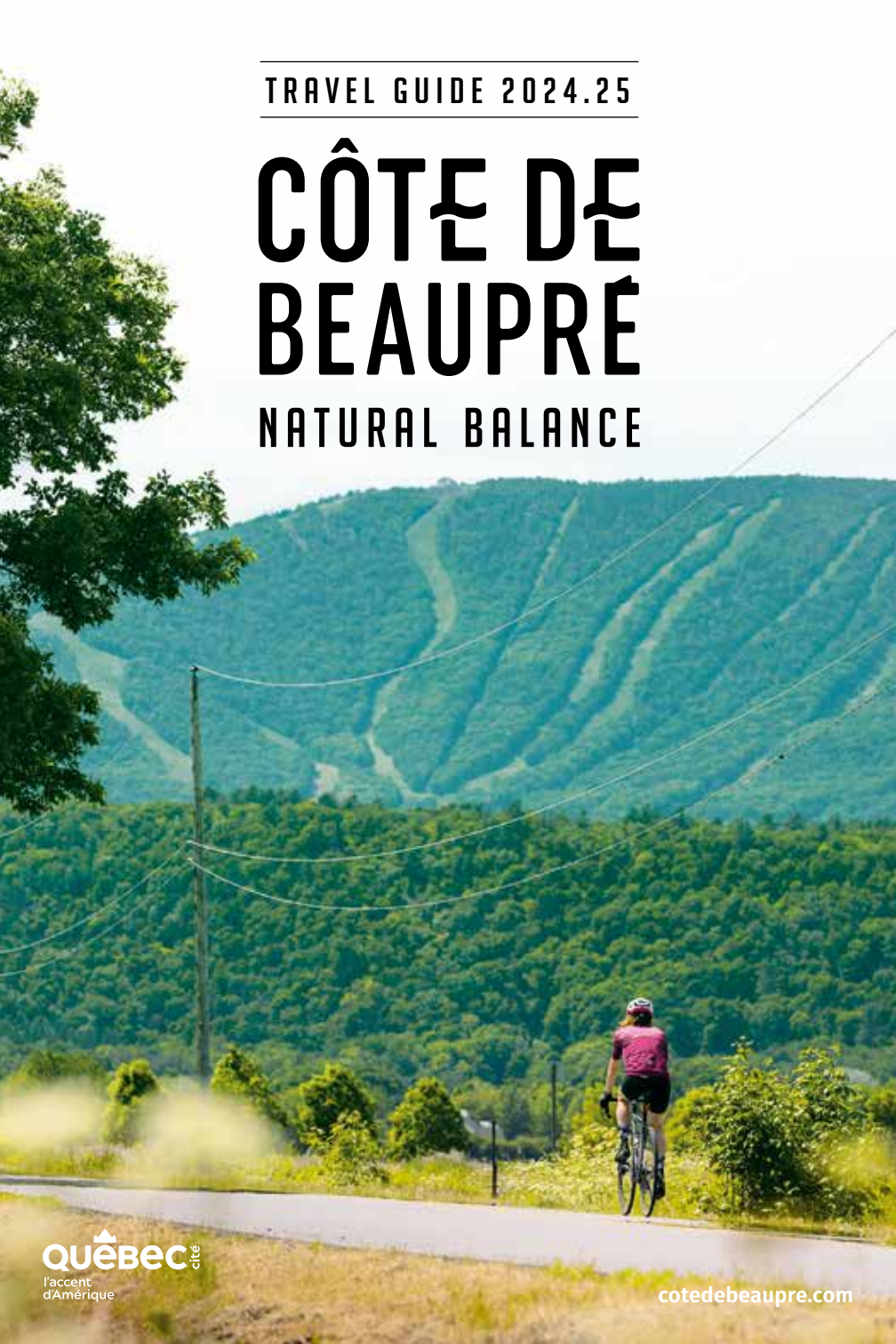

REGIONAL PORTRAIT

CÔTE-DE-BEAUPRÉ

This region has an abundance of exceptional heritage and natural attractions. Travel along the Route de la Nouvelle-France (New France Road), a historical road trip through fascinating cultural, heritage and agritourist sites, including the Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré Basilica, a famous pilgrimage destination.

The Côte-de-Beaupré landscape is characterized by the St. Lawrence River, the Laurentian Mountains, waterfalls and canyon. You can practise a number of four season outdoor recreational activities near Mont-Sainte-Anne or admire the rolling scenery from one of the roadside lookouts, along the St. Lawrence shoreline.

OUR MUST-DOS & MUST-SEES

Parc de la Chute-Montmorency

Minutes away from Old-Québec and offering the perfect blend of history and the great outdoors are the Montmorency Falls. Dominated by an impressive 83-ft waterfall (in all its might!), the site can be observed and enjoyed up close, in all its beauty: choose between a panoramic tour or guided tour, walk the promenade and for the more daring - try its via ferrata!

Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré Shrine

The oldest pilgrimage site in North America, this sanctuary is dedicated to the grandmother of Jesus, Saint Anne. Paintings, mosaics, stained glass, stone, and wood sculptures admirably showcase the extraordinary history of the Sanctuary. Entering the basilica is discovering a sacred place filled with heavenly peacefulness, where religious ornamentation appears like pages from a time-worn history book. Other must-sees are commemorative chapel La Scala Santa, the Saint Anne fountain, and its Stations of the Cross.

Mont-Sainte-Anne

Whether to ski, hike or mountain bike, Mont-Sainte-Anne proposes a full lineup of 4-season activities for fans of the great outdoors. From the summit, why not set out to admire grandiose views of the St. Lawrence River and surrounding Québec City region. In winter, its skiable terrain includes 3 faces offering 71 all-level trails. In summer, choose between several options: 25 km of hiking trails, 135 km of mountain bike trails, a pump track, a frisbee golf course and golf course, a campground... Teeming with exciting activities, Mont-Sainte-Anne is paradise for outdoor sports enthusiasts.

Canyon Sainte-Anne

Located in Saint-Joachim, Sainte-Anne Canyon is the perfect place to go for a forest walk and admire an impressive 74 m waterfall (higher than Niagara Falls!). With several lookouts and suspended bridges, including one at 60 metres, you are free to explore the canyon and its lovely environment. If you'd like to pair contemplation with an adrenaline-packed activity (perfect for the whole family), try the AirCanyon, a sort of merry-go-round that takes you up and over the canyon at a breathtaking 50 km/hr! A unique experience with incomparable, grandiose views.



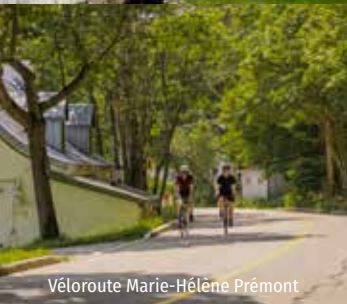

Cap-Tourmente National Wildlife Area

Cap-Tourmente Wildlife Area brims with an array of flora and fauna, as well as scenery from lovely lookouts. Along with its must-visit interpretation centre, explore several short trails that meander through assorted wildlife habitats: Marshes, a coastal plain, yellow, and white birch, beech and balsam fir. Hikers who climb up the Sentier de la Falaise slope are rewarded with an unparalleled view of the St. Lawrence coastline.

Route de la Nouvelle-France

With roadside signs bearing the armories of New France, this 50 km drive invites you out to discover magnificent and historical Avenue Royale (Route 360). With some twenty-five attractions vested in culture, heritage, history and agrotourism, in addition to its lovely landscapes, revel in the old-time feeling of this early roadway, perhaps the oldest in Québec.

Vélouroute Marie-Hélène Prémont Bike Trail

Named after a renowned athlete from this region, Vélouroute Marie-Hélène Prémont bike trail unfurls across about 55 km, traversing an important part of Côte-de-Beaupré's territory while showcasing rue Royale's attractions from an entirely different angle. Known long ago as la Route de Nouvelle-France, it's a lovely blend of nature, culture and fitness on a vast cycling route that starts where the Montmorency Falls bicycle route ends.

Take time to experience the tides and breathe the fresh salty sea air. To cross over to the pier, use Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré Shrine's parking area and its pedestrian tunnel. From the moment you set foot in the municipality of Saint-Joachim, you will discover the ARCHÉOVISION route. The interpretation signs found throughout the village reveal all the area's archaeological wealth. Regular updates made by archaeologists over the years have allowed us to uncover our ancestors' lifestyles. The starting point of this 10-kilometer route takes place at the main sign, located on rue de l'Église, next to Saint-Joachim town hall. This itinerary can be done by foot, by bike or by car, from end of April to end of October.

Only 30 minutes from Québec City, Mont-Sainte-Anne offers 4-season activities in a breathtaking setting.

Hiking :

In summer, explore a 25 km hiking trail network both at the base, and at the summit of MSA. As well, a 25-km trail running course is also accessible (QMT-25). Of note: The gondola ride offers the loveliest sweeping summit views of the region. **Hours:** Open year-round. Assorted seasonal activities.

Mountain Biking :

Mont-Sainte-Anne has the most exciting network of biking trails in Eastern Canada, with 135 km of cross-country bike trails for all levels of ability. The 32-kilometre downhill trail network offers everything from fast-paced adrenaline rushes to turns that are easy for the less experienced to handle. The "Enduro" season pass lets you ride the cablecar free once a day and grants you access to any mountain trail you please. Ten times as much fun-guaranteed! And don't forget about the pump track at the foot of the mountain. No more excuses for not tearing up the trails this summer. **Hours:** May to October.

Open year-round, beautiful Montmorency Falls Park is just a few minutes from downtown Québec City. The waterfalls are 83 m (272') tall, a full 30 m (99') higher than Niagara Falls. Take the cable car up the cliff to start the panoramic walking tour at the Manor, where are housed an interpretation centre, gift shop and restaurant. Follow the footpath along the top of the cliff to the suspended bridge, which affords a splendid view of the area. Keep walking along the path until you get to the 487-step staircase down the side of the cliff that will bring you to the foot of the falls. There are also three via ferrata routes near the falls, along with a 300-m (984.3') double zip line. **Hours:** open year-round, via ferrata from mid-June to mid-October.

At Cap Tourmente, you can admire the gorgeous landscape comprising the St. Lawrence River, large coastal marshes, lowlands and mountains. A major Canadian bird-watching site where you can watch the impressive flocks of Snow Geese that migrate every spring and fall. Twenty kilometres (12 miles) of clearly marked walking trails.

Hours: open year-round. Closed during the holiday season.

Mestachibo Trail, rated intermediate/difficult, is for seasoned hikers. It connects the Saint-Ferréol-les-Neiges church to Jean-Larose waterfalls over a total of 13 linear kilometres. Plan your return transportation in advance! The Mestachibo hugs the Sainte-Anne-du-Nord River almost all the way, and its terrain is rugged, winding through stands of mature trees and rocky ridges with magnificent vistas. From Mont-Sainte-Anne's parking area, the Jean-Larose loop – a 4km round-trip hike rated easy/intermediate – leads to a 300-step staircase along the majestic 75m high Jean-Larose falls, with spectacular viewing decks. **Hours:** Open from sunup to sundown, May 15 to November 30.

Located between Beaufré and Charlevoix, this site allows you to immerse yourself in a pristine natural setting. The gorgeous view of the mountains and St. Lawrence River will leave you breathless. Magnificent old forest with many species of trees. At its Saint-Tite-des-Caps welcome centre or the one in the Le Massif sector, choose between a one-day hiking trip or a multiday (51 km) proposing 2- to 6-day hikes, with luggage transfers and return trip. Lodging in rustic shelters or camping. **Hours:** Open year-round.

Ski and snowboard enthusiasts can carve and ride to their hearts' content at **Mont-Sainte-Anne**, a World Cup venue known for its outstanding terrain! Cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and fatbiking enthusiasts will enjoy the stunning wooded trails at the **Mont- Sainte-Anne Cross-Country Ski Center**.

You can also explore sparkling snowcovered landscapes on **dogsled trails** or marked **snowmobile** trails overlooking the river or try your hand at an activity unique in **North America—ice canyoning!** Not to forget **Le Sentiers des Caps'** longer and shorter hiking itineraries, with overnight stays in rustic shelters.
